Student Account FAQs:

What are Student Music Accounts?

McFarland Music Boosters administers Student Music Accounts for McFarland music students who have participated in specific fundraisers such as Butterbraid, Magazine Sales, Cherrydale and Scrip. The money raised by students through these fundraisers is tracked for each student by the Music Boosters and can be used to pay for music-related activities or expenses. The money in a student's account cannot be redeemed for cash and will forfeit to the McFarland Music Boosters' general fund in the event a student graduates or moves from the district with a balance in their fund.

How can I check if my student has money in their student account?

There is a link in Infinite Campus. Click on "More" and then look for Quick Links. Not all students have participated in fundraisers that fund student accounts.



How do I request money from a student account?

You can find the form on the bottom of the webpage at <u>https://mcfarlandmusicboosters.we</u> <u>ebly.com/student-accounts.html</u>. Requests are reviewed for accuracy. Please use the money in your student account. It can be used for music field trip expenses, for the high school music trip opportunities, for instrument rental or music supplies, marching band polo shirts or Solo & Ensemble accompanist fees. Money that is not used after your child has graduated is rolled over into the Music Boosters' general fund.

The great thing about Scrip is that you can get money for things you were already going to purchase anyway...gas, groceries, dinner, etc. It's easily accessible via your phone, and people can even buy on site while shopping at a store.

How it works:

- 1. Buy gift cards from 750+ brands at face value. The gift cards can be in the form of physical cards, reloadable, or ScripNow eCards.
- 2. Your student and the boosters earn money from the rebate indicated on site.
- Use gift cards for shopping, services, restaurants, or gift giving.

How to get started:

- 1. Complete the enrollment form at <u>www.shopwithscrip.com</u>. Use enrollment code 3FL3ELB857848.
- 2. Verify your account.
- 3. Securely pay with a credit card at checkout or link a bank account before you shop.

If you are ordering physical cards, pick up will be available at the high school.
